Deposit and Final Payment - A deposit of \$150 per person is required to confirm a reservation. Final payment will be due Lawrence Travel Company on or before Friday, October 20, 2023. All deposits and final payments may be made by either cash, check or credit card. Credit card transactions may incur a convenience fee. Insurance is due at deposit if the traveler would like it included.

Cancellation - All deposits are non-refundable. Any cancellations made after final payment, up to Nov. 17th will incur a \$500 per person cancellation fee. Any uninsured cancellations after Nov. 17th, 2023, including, including no-shows, and cancellation while on tour, there is a 100% cancellation penalty. Name changes may be available upon request and will be assessed a \$75 per person name change fee, plus any charges to affect the name change.

Documentation IMPORTANT - Since March 1, 2010, all U.S. citizens - including minors - are required to present a valid passport when traveling to Mexico. Passport cards may NOT be used. U.S. passports must have at least 6 months minimum validity remaining upon return to the U.S. with an expiration date on or after July 31, 2024.

Travel Insurance - Lawrence Travel Company encourages the use of travel insurance for this program. In the unlikely event of accidents and illness, travel insurance insures peace of mind against the unforeseen. Unfortunately, things do sometimes happen and travel insurance can be a big help, both emotionally and financially.

Not Included - Items purely of a personal nature such as gifts and souvenirs, telephone calls, laundry, tours and excursions, and other activities not specified as included in the tour price, customary gratuities to the driver, local guides, interpreters, and assistants, trip cancellation, checked luggage fees and insurance.
